Why are you running for this office? *

I am running for this office because I am deeply committed to serving the residents of our community. Over the years I have witnessed the unique character and values that make our district and our county exceptional, and I am dedicated to preserving these qualities. I believe that my experience, passion, and dedication to addressing critical issues such as mental health, homelessness, public safety, and infrastructure improvements, uniquely qualify and position me to continue serving our community effectively.

Why do you think you are well qualified for this office? As far as you know, who else is running? *

I believe I am extremely well qualified for this office because of my years of service in various community roles, including my current tenure as Supervisor for District 4. My work has allowed me to gain a deep understanding of the needs and concerns of our residents. Furthermore, my commitment to transparent governance and my track record of delivering results demonstrate my experienced qualifications to continue representing our community effectively.

As far as I know, there is one other person running for Placer County Supervisor, District 4. Her name is Karen Henson.

What is your campaign strategy? How much money have you raised as of now? *

My campaign strategy is centered around engaging with our residents through community outreach and communication about what we have accomplished since I was sworn in. Our communication will include how my accomplishments have set the stage for addressing critical issues and preserving our community's values. To date we have raised \$19,575, thanks to the generous support of community members who share our vision for the future of our District and Placer County.

What is your community and GOP involvement? *

I have been actively involved in my community for many years serving in various leadership roles within local organizations such as: The Placer County Older Adult Advisory Commission(6 years); the Granite Bay Municipal Advisory Council (5 years); the 3rd Appellate District Mediation Program, since 2012; and 10 years of service as a Trustee on the Placer County Board of Education, during which I was awarded Trustee of the Year in 2019; working with dedicated individuals who share our values.

My involvement with the Republican Party began when I turned 18, that's when I first registered to vote as a Republican. I have never been registered with any other party.

My active involvement with the Republican Party began in 2007 when I became a member of the Sacramento Republican Women Federated (SRWF). I served as President for 3 years followed by serving as a Regional Coordinator for two additional years overseeing and guiding seven Federated Republican Women's clubs in the Auburn, Roseville, El Dorado, Folsom, and Sacramento area Region.

My involvement with the Placer County GOP began in 2009 as a monthly attendee. In 2010, when I ran for Placer County Board of Education, I participated in a joint canvassing plan organized by then-President Jeff Atteberry. Everyone met at the GOP HQ where each of us gathered all the applicable candidate materials along with the precinct maps and began our walking campaign. I carried my campaign handouts along with handouts for Ted Gaines, Cari Dawson-Bartley, and Eric Bose because all our Districts overlapped. I also placed signs for Cari when I placed my signs because again our Districts overlapped. I also helped other Republicans, like Sue Frost, Sacramento County Supervisor, walk precincts. I worked in Kevin Kiley's Campaign HQ during his race for the CA Senate seat, phone banking, and distributing signs. I also distributed signs for many Republican candidates including Congressman Tom McClintock (multiple years), Ryan Ronco, Pam Tobin, and local school board races. In 2016 I was elected by the voters to represent District 4 on the Central Cmtee. I was elected to serve as the 1st Vice Chair, serving 2016-2020.

My term as first Vice Chair expired at the end of December 2020, at the same time I was sworn in as Placer County Supervisor. At that point, I was no longer a voting member of the Central Cmtee. I have remained available to assist the Central Cmtee if they needed my assistance. I was asked to be a speaker at one of the monthly meetings and I was honored to do so.

I also served as a Team Captain for Placer County for the 2016 Trump Campaign. My responsibilities included hosting Debate Watches and answering and coordinating email questions/inquiries, and distribution of signs, banners, and other campaign paraphernalia.

In addition, I participated with Wynette Sills from the Pro-Life Council, in protesting on Hurley Avenue in front of Planned Parenthood handing out Pro-Life information to potential clients going in and out of the parking lot and displaying signs.

My local Community involvement included serving on the Placer County Older Adult Advisory Commission. Being a Commissioner included serving on the "Placer Protect" Committee. This was an annual Fair for Seniors to demonstrate all the services available to them. "Placer Protect" was hosted by the Placer County District Attorney's office, the Elder Abuse Department, and the Placer County Older Adult Advisory Commission. I was part of the original Cmtee organizing the first annual event in 2017. I have continued to participate to date, even after I became Supervisor by sponsoring the event.

My service to my community included serving on the Policy Review Cmtee, and the Legislative Cmtee for both the CA Counties' Board of Education and the CA School Boards Association being an advocate for and representing Students and Parents.

What are your views on taxes, property rights, LGBT/abortion issues, Black Lives Matter, religious freedom, sanctuary cities, and charter schools? *

Taxes- I believe in fiscally responsible policies that ensure taxes are fair, stable, and that support essential services for all constituents.

Property Rights-I personally believe Personal rights and personal Property rights are fundamental to all. I am a strict Constitutionalist and believe the Constitution stands on its own. It is NOT a "living document" as many liberals profess. I do not support the enforcement of property tax increases.

LGBT Issues- I believe if you are an adult, you have the right to live your life as you choose, so long as you are an adult 18 years of age or older. Having said that, I do not approve of any schools or other organizations having the ability to remove parental rights regarding raising and educating our children. Educating children on the LGBT lifestyle should be prohibited in any school setting when those children are under 18 years old. I also oppose and think schools should be prevented from teaching our children about changing genders, allowing children to receive counseling on/ or having transgender procedures. I think any issues regarding transgenderism in secrecy behind parents' backs must be prohibited by law. Only parents have the right to raise and educate their children on social and especially sexual norms.

I am also vehemently opposed to allowing transgender males to compete in female athletics. This will destroy women's athletic competition, as well as women's chances for Olympic medals, State/National rankings, and College scholarships.

Abortion issues- I do not believe in abortion, especially late-term abortion. I adamantly oppose any government subsidies of abortion both in the civilian sector and I especially object to the US Military subsidizing or paying for any abortion or transgender surgical procedures.

Black Lives Matter- I believe this was another social experiment forced on hard-working, tax-paying Americans to force us to unwillingly accept the far-left liberal movement to usurp unconstitutional changes to this nation.

Religious Freedom- I was raised in the Catholic Religion. In high school, we had to take a class on World Religions and were taught about all the cultural differences in other nations' practices of Religion. In addition to learning about world Religions, I lived in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia for five years. I learned way more than I wanted, about Islam. Although they call Islam a religion, it is basically their culture, their way of life, and the basis for their governance. After learning all this, I still believe all people should have the freedom to practice the religion of their choice. After learning all this, I embrace my Christianity much stronger. I believe it is NOT within the Government's jurisdiction to prevent any of us from worshipping, praying, or practicing our personal right to religious worship, and that was enshrined within the 2nd Amendment.

Sanctuary Cities is just another left-leaning liberal policy to force everyone to accept the left-wing policies that allow breaking the law with regard to illegal immigrants. I do not approve or condone Sanctuary Cities. However, I am enjoying how the Sanctuary Cities are crying foul now that illegal immigrants are invading their protected and privileged communities.

Charter Schools- I am a strong proponent of Charter Schools. I no longer support Public Schools because I believe they have been grossly failing students for the last 20 years. In fact, CA Public Schools were among the top 5 Public Schools in the nation about 40 years ago. Today, CA Public Schools rank around 47th-48th out of 50 states.

As one of seven Trustees on Placer County Board of Ed, we served as an appellate Board reviewing Charter School Petitions for approval after they were denied at the School District level. I was also a proponent of preserving County Boards of Education's approval authority rights when our state Legislature worked to deny this authority. Several County Board Trustees and I stood before the Legislature's Education Committee to fight the legislation that would have eliminated the County Board's approval authority. We, the proponents of Charter Schools prevailed.

What are your views on Covid- mask mandates, vaccine mandates, business shutdowns, schools, etc. *

I vehemently opposed any of these mandates. I was the only Placer Supervisor who announced publicly, at a Board of Supervisor's meeting, on the dais that I would NOT support any vaccination, or mask mandates. I also did not believe in closing small businesses. I adamantly opposed school shutdowns and student mask mandates. Both the Shutdowns and the mask/vaccination mandates harmed a full generation of students and permanently damaged their ability to excel/succeed. I will never support this to be forced on schools again in the future.

After COVID was determined to be ended. I aided the small businesses in Granite Bay, by personally delivering information that these small businesses could apply for ARPA grant money if their businesses suffered as a result of the COVID shutdowns. I personally delivered these applications to 40 small businesses in Granite Bay.

What is your position on the Second Amendment? *

I firmly believe in the Second Amendment and the rights of law-abiding citizens to bear arms. I believe in providing for the safety of our communities while respecting the rights of gun owners. We must be able to ensure public safety as well as our individual liberties, and our 2nd Amendment right to possess and bear arms.

Have you endorsed, supported, or contributed to a non-Republican candidate in the past 4 years? *

No. To my knowledge, I have never endorsed a member of any other party, to include any Republican that was once registered as a Democrat.

Do you pledge to endorse only Republican candidates this election cycle? *

Yes, I Pledge to only endorse Candidates that are registered Republicans. I have even greater respect for candidates that have been life-long Republicans and have never been registered to another party.
